#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

about responsibility of

foreign citizens



and non-residents crossing the boarder of the Russian Federation for drug dealing

On the territory of the Russian Federation free circulation of drugs is strictly prohibited.

Persons for actions performed on the territory of the Russian Federation connected with illicit drug trafficking, **are made criminally responsible**, with subsequent prohibition of entrance the territory of the Russian Federation until their civil rights are restored or they are cleared of criminal records.

Criminal responsibility is inflicted irrespective of racial, sexual or national belonging of a person committed a crime.

Persons are made criminally responsible for illegal buying, storing, transporting and making drugs as provided for in Article 228 of the Criminal Code of the Russian Federation, envisaging 15 years of imprisonment.

Persons are made criminally responsible for producing, selling and posting drugs as provided for in Article 228.1 of the Criminal

# Code of the Russian Federation <u>envisaging up to life of</u> <u>imprisonment</u>.

Persons are made criminally responsible for transporting drugs across the boarders of the Russian Federation by provisions of Article 229.1 of the Criminal Code of the Russian Federation, envisaging <u>20</u> <u>years of imprisonment</u>.

Foreign citizens are made **administratively responsibility** for storing minor quantities of drugs, their addiction and propaganda of there spreading by provisions of Part 6 of the Administrative Code envisaging, banishment with further prohibition of the entrance the territory of the Russian Federation for 5 years or **deportation** as provided for by Russian administrative law.

If you have voluntarily handed over drugs to lawenforcement bodies and actively assisted the investigation, you are exonerated from criminal responsibility.

To inform about a crime or voluntarily hand over drugs you may in Head offices of the Service of the Russian Federation for Controll of Drugs Circulation
